**Course Title: Art for Pleasure - Enrichment Art** 

**Learning Intention: Title:** 6E1.3 SUM Screen printing & Exploring Colour

This Scheme of work is followed by pupils studying Art and Design for Pleasure in the Summer Term. The Purpose of this Scheme of work is to build pupils' understanding of methods of using & applying colour for a purpose and learn therapeutic qualities of working with colour. They do this through Screen printing for a parade & colour in mindfulness drawing, painting. Developing wider knowledge of how to apply technical skills from Autumn Term printing and creatively explore the meaning of colour and its varied meanings through Mindfulness Art and Indigenous American Dreamcatchers. Pupils improve their knowledge and understanding by:

- Creating practical Art to be used as part of a Parade, celebrating diversity -Flag or T-shirt Design (paper & Fabric)
- Developing their ability to cut stencils safely and print more independently
- Exploring Colour and how it has meaning for different people
- Experimenting with colour & how it can be used to support wellbeing

Learning Through both technical and experimental application- improving ability to master a technical process as well as creatively explore loose colour effects and their therapeutic qualities.

- 4. Worksheets checking knowledge of Pride rainbow/define printing knowledge
- 5. Mindfulness Mandalas and paint explorations
- 6. Making a 3D DreamCatcher-Straw/masking tape/feathers
