Concept:

Students will work through the unit completing focused activities in groups and independently to: familiarise themselves with being exposed to illegal, inappropriate or harmful material, and online interaction with other users. They will demonstrate what they have learnt throughout informatively and summatively.

Knowledge:

- Improve general knowledge surrounding social media
- Look at the usefulness of information.

- Try to find and select information that informs and clarifies the task
- Begin to show an awareness of the ways a lack of information limits their work

- Analyse information visually/verbally
- Suggest alternative ways the participants could have acted
- Describe what online bullying is
- Suggest ways to prevent social media being hacked
