Dear Parents and Carers

We hope you are enjoying a well-earned and restful summer break with friends and families.

We are emailing you to update you on the opening to our Northwood Road Campus in September. Regrettably and, for reasons beyond the control of the school, the opening of the new site has been delayed by one week. This means that the site will now be open to students from Monday 21st September.

We are writing to inform you of this and to also outline the steps we have taken to minimise the impact of this on you and your children. We have also attached a social story to assist you in explaining this situation to your child.

Week beginning 7th September

No change. Students working at home through the work booklets. These will be distributed to you between 2nd, 3rd, 4th September and will also be available on our website. We will still be running the Northwood Bake Off event on Friday 11th September in the park in Harefield.

During this week you will also receive a phone call from your child's class team to check in on how the work is going and to keep in touch more generally.

Week beginning 14th September

You will be issued a second booklet to complete at home. This booklet will follow the curriculum pathway for your child and will be adapted to the needs of the class they are in. Work in this booklet will be collected and feedback will be given on it. This booklet will be distributed in the week beginning 7th September.

You will receive further communication by phone from the class team for your child and you will also receive the first class newsletter of the year.

Week beginning 21st September

School will begin for students this week and specific details will be sent to you nearer the time if needed.



On Monday 21st September students in Year 7 only will be on site. All other year groups and Year 7 will be in school from Tuesday 22nd September.

If your child is eligible for transport to Northwood Road it will begin from Tuesday 22nd September for all students. Unfortunately, Year 7 students will need to make their own transport arrangements for the Monday 21st September.

We appreciate that this situation is not ideal, but hope this letter reassures you that we are doing all we can to minimise the disruption and the impact on your child's education. If, however, there are any questions please contact the Headteacher at meadow@meadowhighschool.org.
