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## Learning Intention: Title: 601.3SUM 'Learning to be a Practising Artist- Guided Study Focus'

This Scheme of work is followed by pupils studying GCSE/AS Level Art and Design in the Summer Term. The purpose is to give pupils the opportunity to develop their independent work ethic needed to study the GCSE/AS exam in their second year. The unit allows pupils the opportunity to identify and work on the skills/techniques needed to meet GCSE/AS Level criteria for AO2/AO3. All pupils will be taught to use Digital Art in their coursework, to refine previous work and to expand their creativity, skills and techniques inspired by artists that they choose to look at. The first half 3a teaches adapting images digitally and also focuses on reviewing and improving previous work. In the second half 3b pupils produce a refining ideas Mind map or statement of intent and look at 1-2 specific Artists that link to their coursework, they focus on a specific skill from the artist to develop and adapt in their work.

Elements from AQA Unit 113000 Digital Art: Exploring techniques and AQA criteria 118115 Expanding skills and Techniques Form part of the course.
