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Learning Intention: Title: 601.2SPR 'Developing My Coursework Topic' In The News-GCSE or Self selected topic for AS Level.

This Scheme of work is followed by pupils studying GCSE/AS Level Art and Design in the Spring Term. The purpose of the scheme of work is to develop pupils' creativity and ability to follow the main developmental criteria for the GCSE/AS Fine Art or Graphic Communication coursework. This project is split into 2 units, pupils focus on developing the skills and work needed to achieve part of their coursework in year 1 of GCSE/AS Level. Pupils in the first year of study will follow the Topic 'In the News' whilst pupils studying AS Level will select their own topic area.

Pupils use a study booklet for the second part of the project and for their mock. Pupils either complete set Teacher led outcomes/criteria or study AQA Level 1 Unit113888 Stencil Art studied in their 3 day Mock (depending on their pace and study inclinations). The Mock includes an art trip to Uxbridge Galleries or the Sculpture park. Those submitted for GCSE or AS Level will use any AQA unit completed units as part of their Coursework. AS students complete an additional Mock day.

The units are: 2a Developing ideas through investigation (AO1) 2b.Exploring & Experimenting with ideas (AO2) Mock Week-Teacher led Criteria or AQA unit **113888 Stencil Art**

key Elements: Main developmental criteria for GCSE and AS Level teaching due to combined class main approach to learning is taught to GCSE, and AS Level pupils criteria adapted by the teacher with extra emphasis on personal study and homework for those studying AS Level..

- Exploring a range of Mixed drawing media both wet and dry
- Observational studies based on Artist research and Direct Observation

Learning through developing the understanding of specific criteria requirements, deciding, exploring and starting to develop the coursework intentions.

- Pupils are supported through step by step checklists to encourage pupils to select areas that need to be developed more independently, they are also extended by the opportunity to experience a 3 day mock exam/workshop including a trip, in order to help prepare them for their exam next year. Pupils studying AS will do 3 days +trip.
- Assessment forms part of the ongoing: teach, review, marking and planning cycle, pupils are assessed on their ability to meet the qualification criteria and keyword recall.
