RED FLAGS: We need to know if there is...

1. Reoccurring use of their blue inhaler (on a weekly basis)

2. Unable to fully participate in school activities due to Asthma.

3. School absence due to Asthma.

4. Any concerns that school staff may have about a child.

REMEMBER If a child is needing their blue inhaler more than once within 4 hours - send home, let parents know and advise to see GP
