  - What do pirates <u>do</u> and <u>say</u>?


<u>Next</u>:

- Practise speaking in a pirate captain voice:


<u>Remember:</u> The Captain is in charge and tells the other pirates what to do so make your voice loud and clear!

"Swab the decks!" "Climb the rigging!" "Polish the port holes!" "Mend the mast!" "Sew the sails!"












Talk about the jobs you can see the pirates doing. Which job would want you do?





"Enough, enough," the Captain cried, "no need to go berserk. 2 minutes more will do no harm and so get back to work!"






"There's **washing** to scrub and **hats** to stitch and **cracks** in the hull to seal with pitch."
