“Polish the port holes!”

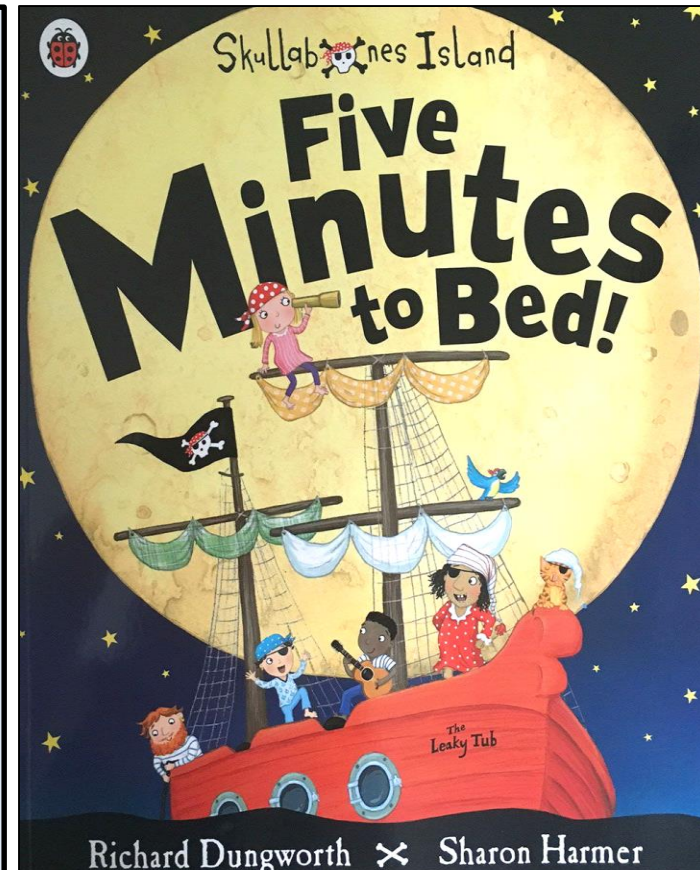
“Mend the mast!”

“Bedtime me hearties!”

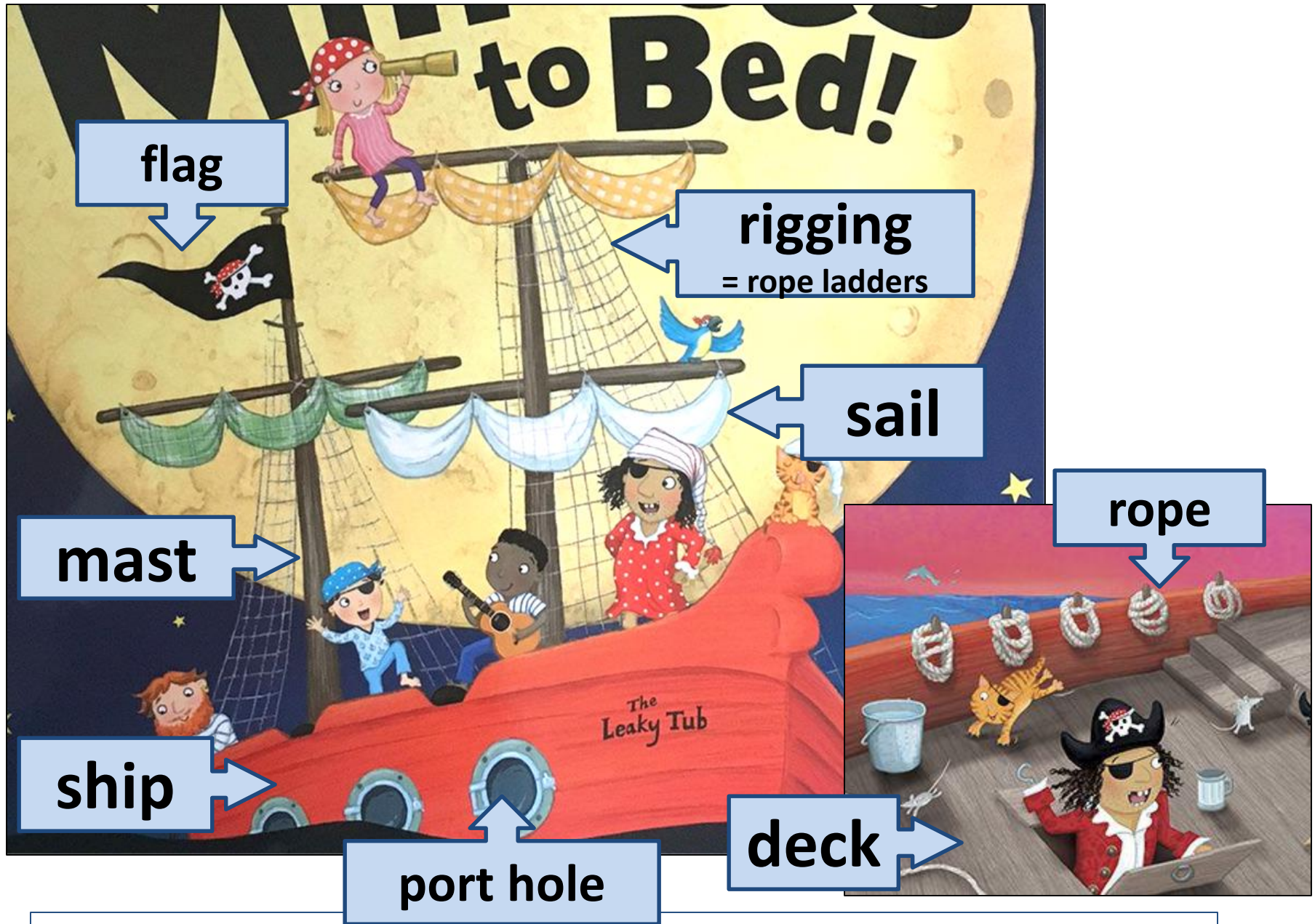


Finally: **Listen along** and **talk about** the story.

Talk about the jobs you can see the pirates doing. Which job would you want to do?

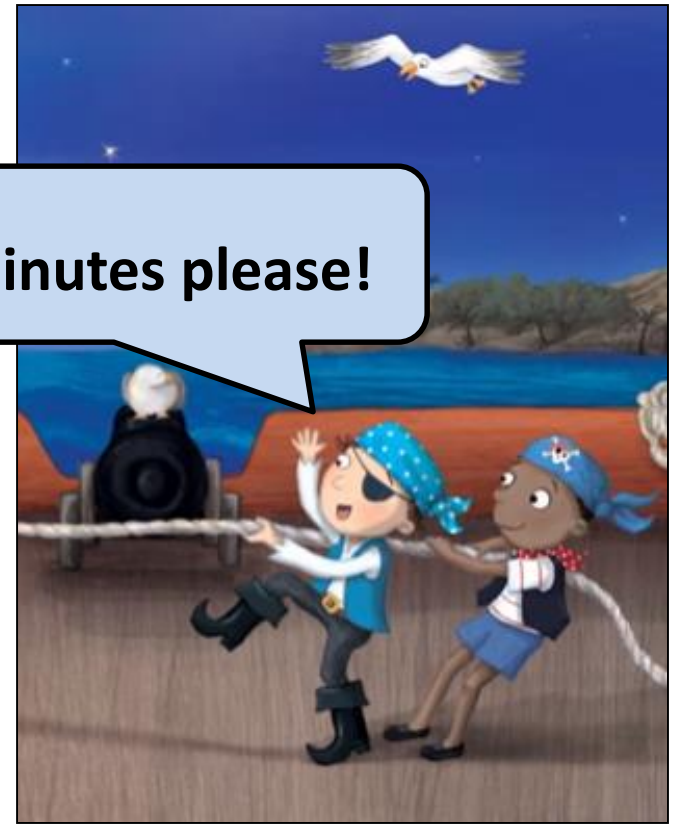
