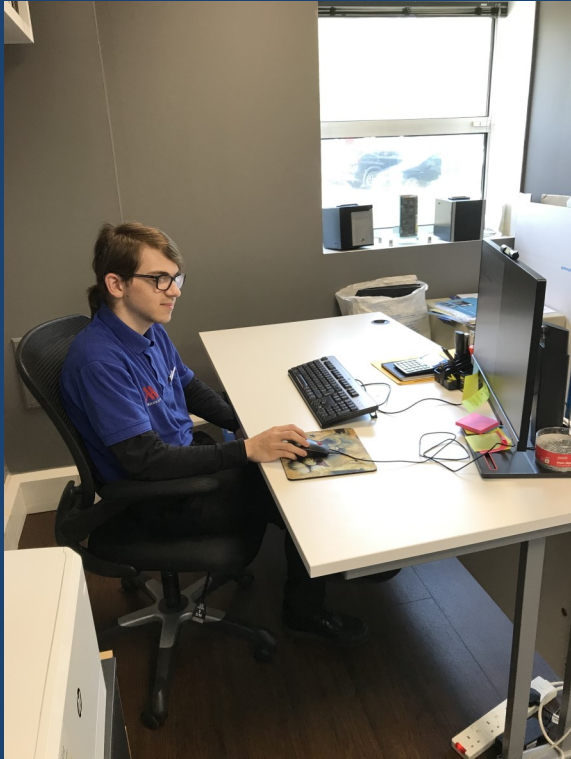
Sharmarke
