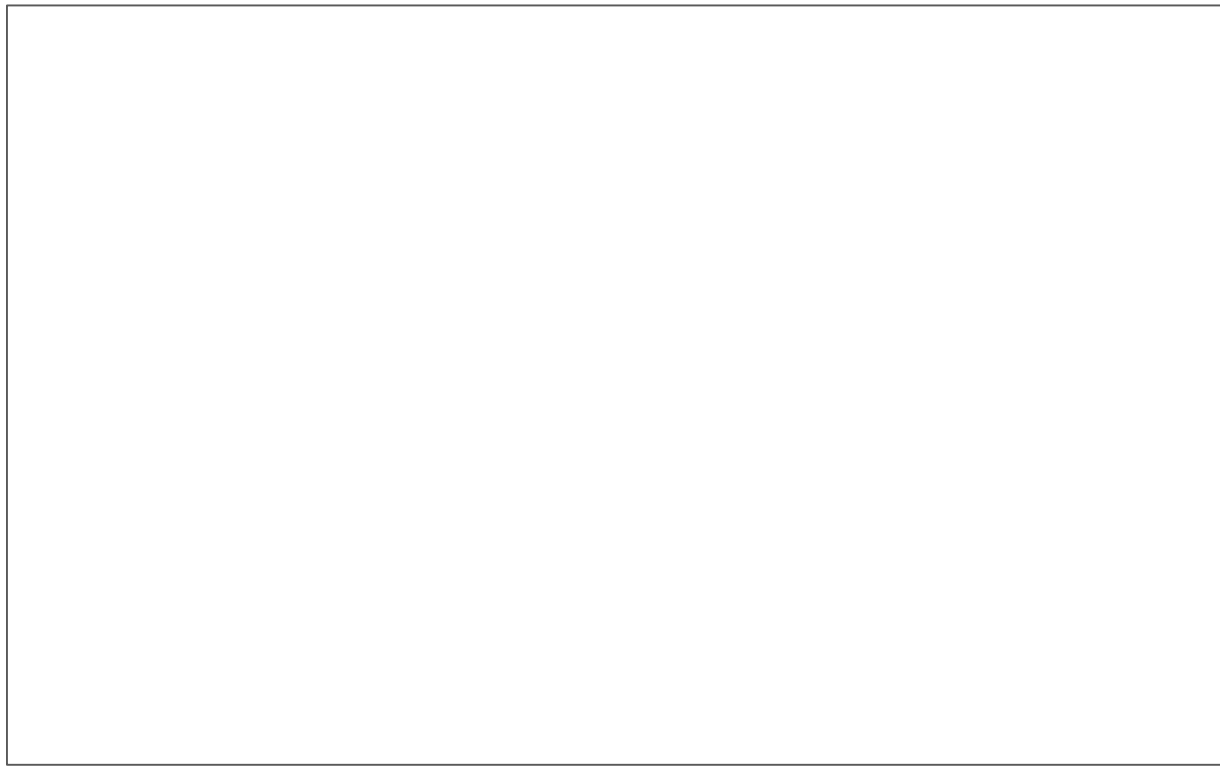

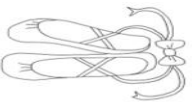

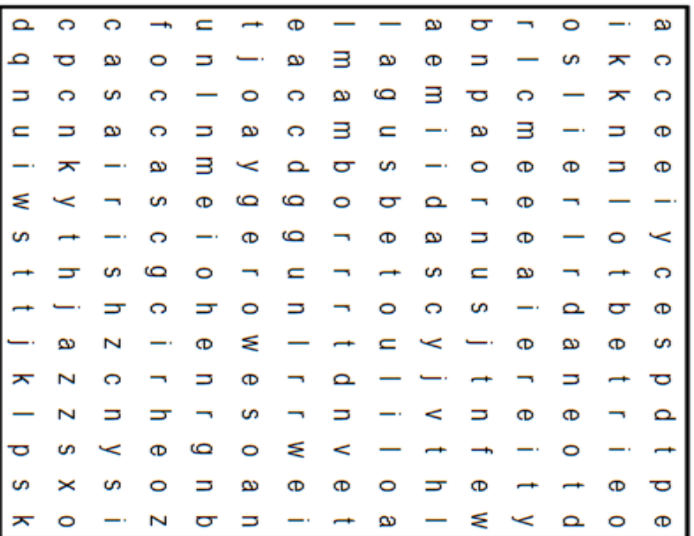

This Dance themed Word Scramble features 10 Dance themed words which have been scrambled. See if you can unscramble them to see what they are.



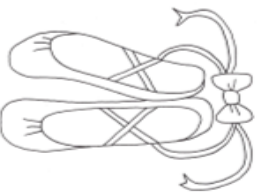

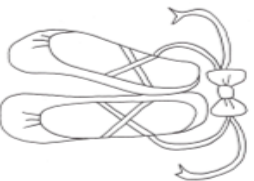
